What To Expect

1. Booking and Planning

If you're thinking about booking a session, please reach out and send me a message. We will talk or email about what you're looking for in your photos and your vision for the session. If you don't know where to start, that's ok too! I'll send you a link to my senior questionnaire. This will help me get to know you and give me ideas for your senior session. Just tell me a little about yourself and I'll suggest a game plan and location ideas. We'll reserve your session date, I'll send you an invoice for your deposit, and then it's official!

2. Your Session

This is the fun part! We'll meet for your photo shoot and spend time together creating amazing images. I'll help you with any and all posing while making the session as fun as possible! Most sessions tend to last about an hour, but longer sessions are an option as well.

3. Your Images

After we meet, I'll spend time culling through and editing the best shots from your session. Within about two weeks, I will send you an email with the link to your online gallery. View and download your beautiful portraits and use them to your heart's content however you'd like! Add-on products such as albums are also available.



helpful TIPS

Take some time at least a couple weeks before your session to plan your outfits. Try them on well in advance and make sure they are comfortable.

Make sure your outfits are wrinkle free and placed on a hanger. (This includes any jewelry and accessories)

Try to avoid sun burns and visible tan lines in the weeks leading up to your session.

Manicure nails since they will be visible in some photos.

If the shoes you have planned for photos are uncomfortable, bring along another pair of comfy shoes for walking from location to location.

Bring along lip gloss, any makeup or hair products for touch-ups, a snack and water.

What to wear



When preparing for your senior session, it can seem like a daunting task figuring out what to wear. The main objective is to choose outfits that will photograph well and also show your style, making you feel confident and comfortable.

Here are a few tips on what to wear:

Your senior photos reflect your personal style, so dress in clothing that is “you” but kick it up a notch.

Add layers and accessories. Layers add dimension to your outfit and make it more interesting. Don't be afraid to add scarves, blazers, jackets, belts, jewelry, and hats.

Add some visual interest to your images with texture and unique fabrics. Some examples: lace, cable knits, chambray, tweed, faux fur, wool. Patterns and prints can work great in moderation.

If you're shooting in multiple outfits, include at least one dressy or classic and one fun/-casual option.

Feel free to bring along any props that are meaningful to you. Sports equipment, jerseys/uniforms/letter jackets, musical instruments, skateboard, fishing gear, art and books, etc. Be creative and bring any items that show your passions and we will incorporate them into your session. Pets are welcome too!

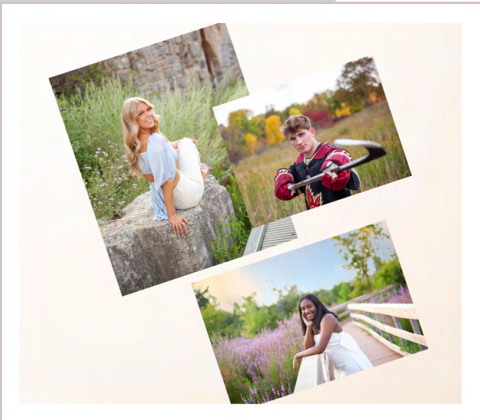

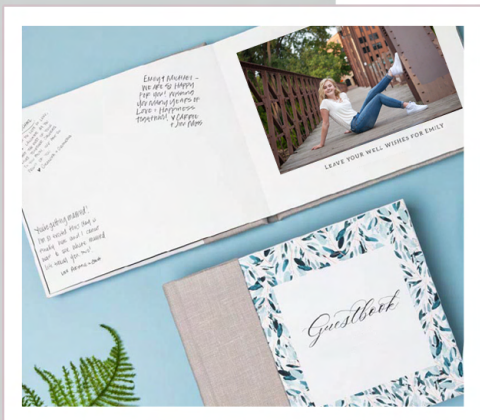

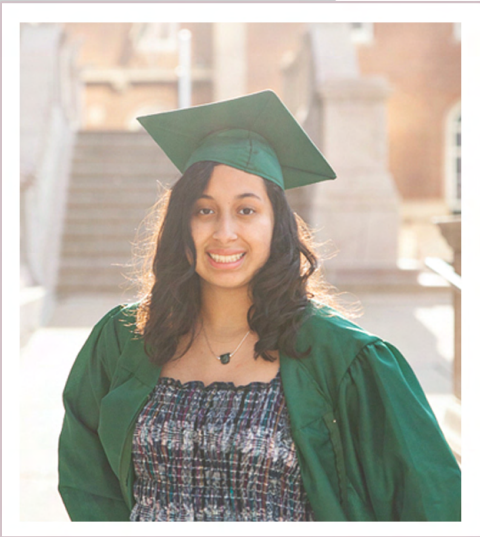


GUEST BOOK

A personalized memory book to use as a sign-in or fill-in book at graduation events and parties. Each page has space for writing as well as photos from your senior session.

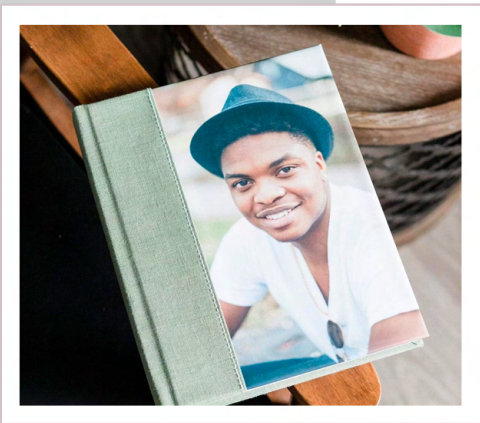

Location IDEAS



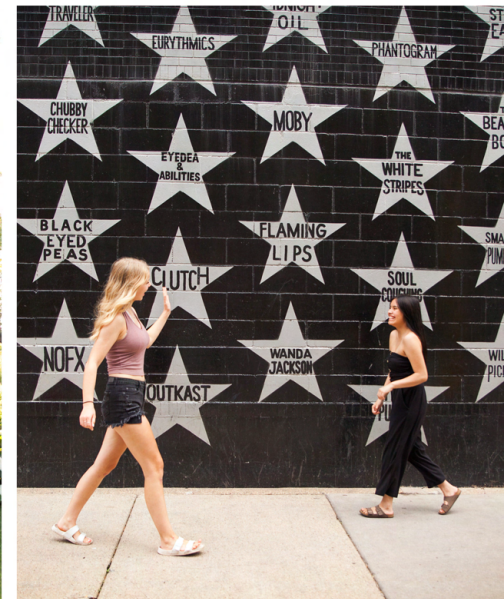
St. Anthony Main

FAQ's

What if it rains?

I watch the weather very closely and if it looks like we will get rained out, or if the heat/humidity is excessive, we will reschedule. If it's not raining, keep in mind that cloudy days often make for excellent lighting for photos.

Can you retouch blemishes?

Yes, I retouch all purchased photos and digital files at no additional charge.

When will my photos be ready?

Your digital files will be ready for downloading approximately 2 weeks after your session. If you are purchasing additional items, most take about 2-3 weeks.

When is the best time to take senior photos?

The most common time is the summer between your junior and senior years, or sometime in the fall of your senior year. If your school yearbook requires a photo to be submitted by a certain date, the earlier you can book your session, the better.

Can I bring a friend to our session?

Of course! I encourage you to bring along a friend or family member who will help you feel more relaxed in front of the camera. If you prefer not to bring anyone, that's fine too!
